Madison County Right To Life

MADISON COUNTY RIGHT TO LIFE HOSTS MICAELLA CLAY, NATIONALLY KNOWN ABORTION SURVIVOR

At the first annual membership meeting possible in three years due to COVID, Madison County Right to Life was honored to host nationally known abortion survivor, Micaella Clay, who shared her amazing story. Micaella was born prematurely as the result of a vacuum abortion performed at a traveling abortion clinic. Micaella's desperate mother, who showed up at the abortion clinic with her 2 year old son, became so panicked after Micaella's live birth, that she left the abortion clinic without either Micaella or her 2 year old son. What followed this abandonment was a long chain of foster homes, finally culminating in the adoption of both Micaella and her brother by a loving adoptive family. Micaella spoke of her journey and how, although she suffers from lifelong health problems due to the abortion she survived, she thanks God for the life with which she has been blessed. Micaella is a mother of two and a strong advocate for life. In her talk, Micaella emphasized that every life is precious and important. She encouraged support for pregnancy resource centers to help desperate women like her mother. Micaella explained that she thinks of herself not as pro-life, because this term has unfortunately become politicized, but instead as pro-love, pro-community, and pro-support. Micaella closed with a saying she always tells her children, "Always seek the giant." In the fight to protect life, we are truly up against giants, the giants of money, political influence, government interference, willful ignorance, and evil. However, we have something that overcomes all of those giants, the love and support of God. Please pray for the protection of all life, not just including the unborn but also those vulnerable among us, the disabled, the elderly, and the mentally ill. God has a purpose for each of us.

We were also honored by the appearance of Mayor Robert Blythe, who opened our meeting with prayer. Sen. Jared Carpenter gave an overview of pro-life laws which had been passed in Kentucky and encouraged support for the constitutional amendment on the ballot in November. Congressman Andy Barr also spoke about the current presidential administration's push to pass legislation which would give the United States a more extreme policy on abortion than even China and North Korea, two countries that have horrible human rights records. Please pray that the hearts and minds of our leaders are changed to respect and protect human life.



Our president, Connie Wason, closed with encouragement to work hard to educate people about Constitutional Amendment No. 2. For more information on this, see pages 2 and 3 of this newsletter. Connie ended the meeting with the following quote from St Augustine of Hippo: Hope has two beautiful daughters, their names are Anger and Courage. Anger at the way things are, and Courage to see that they do not remain as they are.

MYTH: The Yes for Life Amendment "will harm everyone, but the most vulnerable Kentuckians will suffer the worst effects."

FACT: The ProLife movement in Kentucky is dedicated to protecting the most vulnerable among us: the unborn. The Yes for Life Amendment will enshrine Kentucky values into our Constitution.

MYTH: The Yes for Life Amendment will make Kentucky an outlier among other states.

FACT: Multiple states have added similar amendments to their state constitutions to protect the sanctity of life, including Tennessee, Alabama, West Virginia, and Louisiana.

DON'T BE MISLED BY THE LIES OF PRO-ABORTION FORCES

There is nothing in Constitutional Amendment No. 2 that limits or prevents women from receiving medical treatment for a miscarriage or tubal pregnancy. **A miscarriage is not an abortion.** A miscarriage occurs when a woman's body can no longer sustain a pregnancy and the baby dies. This is a medical condition for which treatment would never be denied. A tubal or ectopic pregnancy occurs when a fertilized egg implants outside of the uterus, most commonly in the Fallopian tubes. This can be a life-threatening medical condition to the pregnant woman; and it is a condition in which the baby cannot survive. Again, treatment for this medical condition would never be denied. **Treatment of a tubal pregnancy does not constitute an abortion.** The baby in a tubal pregnancy is never viable as there is no way currently to transplant the embryo from its implantation outside of the uterus back into the correct location inside the uterus.

Pro-abortion forces are lying and employing scare tactics to convince people that voting yes for Constitutional Amendment No. 2 will make women second-class citizens and restrict their educational opportunities, access to medical treatment, access to contraception, etc. This is simply not true. All that Constitutional Amendment No. 2 does is affirm that **there is no right to abortion or the funding of abortion in Kentucky's Constitution.** We think everyone in Kentucky can agree that there are much better uses for public funding rather than killing babies.

VOTE PRO-LIFE THIS NOVEMBER

In addition to Constitutional Amendment No. 2, there are a number of political offices at stake in which your pro-life vote can make a difference. Some of these races include Sen. Rand Paul, Rep.
