THE RAPE AND INCEST EXCEPTION ARGUMENT

Recently, due to campaign ads from Gov. Andy Beshear, there has been a heavy focus on the rape and incest exception to abortion argument. No matter the circumstances of its conception, each life is uniquely created by God for a special purpose in His will and that purpose should not be subverted by man.
